QUALIFICATIONS: In order to advance to a National Dual Championship, your team's members must participate in your AAU District Qualifier. If your District is not conducting an AAU District Qualifier, your team members can advance directly to the National Dual Championship.

Weigh-ins: Friday April 18th, 2014 at venue 5:00 until 8:00 p. m. Must weigh-in as a team with all members present. Wrestlers must weigh-in wearing a singlet.

Team Awards: Top 3 teams in each championship bracket will receive a team award. **Individual Awards**: Undefeated wrestlers will receive a Gold Medal, 1 loss a Silver Medal, 2 losses a Bronze Medal and 3 losses a Cooper Medal. Wrestlers must wrestle at least 6 matches to qualify for the medals.
