#### AWARDS

Awards will be given to the top six placers in each weight class. Team trophies for Club Championship.

### **NATIONAL TEAM QUALIFICATION**

The top 8 placers in all divisions except Juniors qualify automatically for the Western Regional Kids/Cadet Championships in Pocatello, Idaho in June. Wrestlers must qualify at the weight they intend to wrestle at Western Regionals. Wrestlers who do not automatically qualify must apply through the petition process for any open spots that become available.

This tournament is also the official qualifying event for all Utah Freestyle National Teams for Schoolboys, Cadets, and Juniors. Wrestlers must qualify at the weight at which they intend to compete at National Duals and/or at the Asics Cadet & Junior National Championships in Fargo (challenge matches will happen in the case weights are different). The champions of the Schoolboy, Cadet and Junior divisions win the right to be on the national teams for the national duals events. Junior division champions also win the right to represent Team Utah at the Junior Western Duals. Only the top 3 placers in the Cadet and Junior divisions gain automatic qualifying spots for Fargo. In the event that any of the top three placers for Fargo, do not have their National Teams deposits (explained below) paid online by the national teams deposit deadline, any open spots on the national team will be open to the next highest placer in the weight class. In the event the Freestyle & Greco State Champions do not have their deposit paid online for the National Duals Teams by the deposit deadline their spot will be open for the coach to fill.

### **Challenge Matches**

For those athletes that are wanting to go one weight for Fargo and another weight for the duals and also those that do want to participate in the duals but do not end up winning their weight at state you do have a chance to challenge for the dual spot at a different weight. Below are the criteria for challenge matches:

- All Challenge matches: Challenger has to win 2 of 3 / wrestler getting challenged only has to win one
- Winner of cadets can challenge winner of juniors at his weight or one weight up for that spot – only one challenge.
- If Junior loses challenge to cadet they can challenge up a weight.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place cadets can challenge up one or two weights in Cadet but not both and up in Juniors if 1<sup>st</sup> place does not challenge that same guy.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> place schoolboy can challenge up one or two weights in schoolboy but not both.
- In order to challenge you have to have your deposit money in hand fully committed to go.
- If a Cadet wants to wrestle Junior in Fargo they must wrestle Cadet at State to qualify for the Cadet Duals Team and can challenge up for the Junior Division if need be for Fargo.
- All State Champions from Schoolboy, Cadet, and Junior Division must check to see if they have a challenge match before they leave tournament on Friday and Saturday.
- All challenge matches must be requested before final match of the night is wrestled.

### **NATIONAL TEAM DEPOSITS DEADLINE – payment due online on May 1<sup>st</sup> at 11:59 PM**

All deposits for national teams are due May 1<sup>st</sup> by 11:59 PM. These may be paid at <https://wrestleutah.wufoo.com/forms/sbcadetjunior-application/>. Select the event you wish to participate in, register, and then pay at least the minimum deposit to reserve your spot on the national team. At 11:59 PM, May 1<sup>st</sup>, any spots remaining on the national team will be offered to the other placers in each available weight class. The minimum required deposits are listed below as well as the dates of the different national events requiring deposits:

June 6-11	Schoolboy National Duals in Indianapolis, Indiana (\$250 minimum deposit)
June 11-17	Cadet National Duals in Daytona Beach, Florida (\$250 minimum deposit)
June 15-16	Junior Western Duals in Pocatello, Idaho (\$50 total cost)
June 17-23	Western Regionals in Pocatello, ID for divisions INTERMEDIATE through CADET (See website for breakdown of costs)

June 26-July 1 Junior National Duals in Oklahoma City, Oklahoma (\$250 minimum deposit)

July 13-21 Cadet and Junior Nationals in Fargo, North Dakota (\$250 minimum deposit)

### **LAYOUT, FLOOR ACCESS, AND FACILITIES**

All rounds will be wrestled on 10 full mats. Admission is free to spectators and full concessions will be available throughout the tournament. We ask that spectators please remain off the arena floor so the tournament can run smoothly. Wrestlers and coaches only on the floor. Only 2 coaches in a corner. Coaches will need to check in to get their wristbands. Coaches with a USA Coaches Card will receive a coaches band.

Adequate room at the base of the lower seating level provides adequate room for those wishing to video tape matches.

### **LODGING AND DINING**

Nearby Bountiful, Farmington, and Layton provide many lodging and dining options. Those wishing to park mobile homes or 5<sup>th</sup> wheels on-site may do so in the Northwest parking lot only.
